We have an extensive retailer network covering the UK and some overseas countries. Through this network we supply seating for home comfort offering an extensive range of rise and recliners to meet all needs and specialist health chairs into care homes, hospitals, charities, hospices and many other organisations.

We are known for our bespoke furniture and this has established us as a major supplier in our marketplace and we continue to innovate to create new solutions such as the Harlem Porter, our new chair designed for people with Huntington's disease.
